Responsibilities:

The Indigenous EarlyON Centre is a program for all Indigenous families for children ages 0-6 years which reflects the unique cultures, aspirations and needs of the Urban Indigenous children and families. The position is responsible for coordinating the daily delivery of the EarlyON Centre through;

- Providing cultural based programming, workshops, and services to meet the needs of the Indigenous Community in the Niagara Region.
- Coordinate, plan, and deliver high quality services outlined by the EarlyON Child and Family guidelines for children from birth to 6 years and their parents/caregivers.
- Supporting early learning and development through playgroups and parent education with respect to child development.

Qualifications:

- Diploma in Early Childhood Education and registered with good standing with the College of Early Childhood Education.
- Understanding of the issues that affect Indigenous children, parents and caregivers.
- Certificate in First Aid and CPR.
- Knowledge of culturally safe child development, Indigenous curriculum and Ontario's Pedagogy for the Early Years (How does Learning Happen).
- Excellent computer, strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Demonstrated skills on working collaboratively with community partners on early learning initiatives.
- Able to work independently and within a team approach.
- **Must have valid driver's licence, Insurance and reliable vehicle.**
- **Must have or able to obtain a clear CPIC for the Vulnerable Sector.**
