How Niagara Regional Native Centre (NRNC) Membership Works

- An annual purchase of membership is required each year by the start of the NRNC Fiscal Year, April 1st.
- You must be considered a member in good standing at all times to vote, including at any Annual General Meeting and other special membership meetings.
- The renewal date stamp on your membership card is your receipt of renewal and payment received.
- All applicants 18 years and older are considered adults and must submit a separate membership application form to be considered for a ratified membership.

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP:

- A Regular Voting Member: must be a member in good standing, 18 years of age and older, of Indigenous descent, and reside within the NRNC catchment area.
- An Associate Non-Voting Member: must be a member in good standing.
- An Honorary Voting Member: must be a member in good standing, 65 years of age plus, of Indigenous decent, and reside within the NRNC catchment area. The process of choosing an honourary member usually involves the nomination, selection, and approval of individuals by a committee, board, or council within the organization, symbolizing a collective recognition, embrace, and welcome of the chosen individual/s into the honourary membership.
- **An Honorary Non-Voting Member:** must be a member in good standing and selected specifically. The process of choosing an honourary member usually involves the nomination, selection, and approval of individuals by a committee, board, or council within the organization, symbolizing a collective recognition, embrace, and welcome of the chosen individual/s into the honourary membership.
- A Group/Organization Membership: must be individuals in good standing with NRNC and visibly demonstrate a desire to contribute to the Niagara Regional Native Centre in a good way.

HOW TO APPLY FOR MEMBERSHIP

- Please bring your completed application form/s to the reception desk at the head office along with
 proof of your Indigenous status and residency. A staff person or Board of Director/s member will view
 your documents in person and witness/sign your application. This allows the Board of Directors (BOD) to
 determine the membership type eligibility for each applicant.
- No payment is required until the Board of Directors has ratified applications. You will be notified via a
 welcome letter/email and invited to visit the reception at the Centre to pay your fee and collect your
 date stamped Member's Card. (There will be a small replacement fee for lost cards).
